

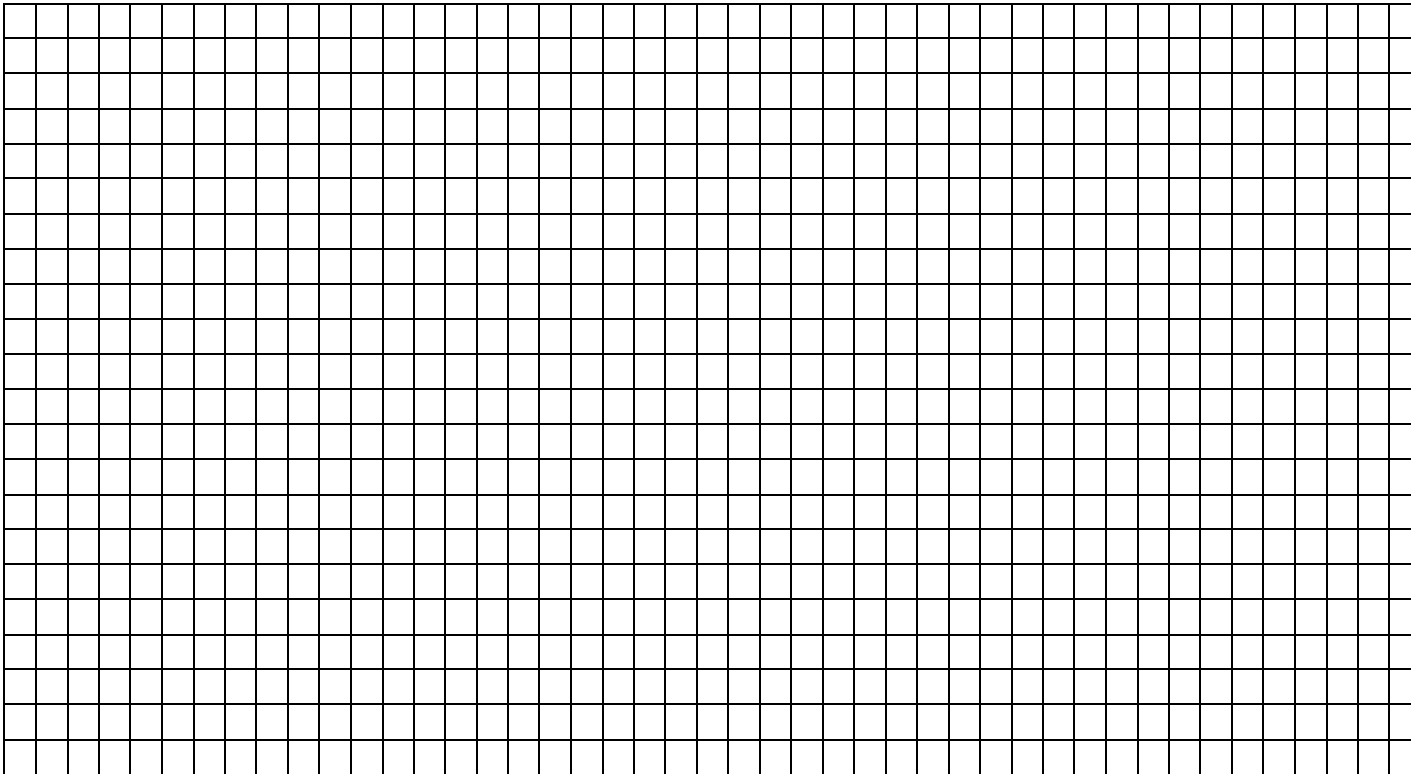


Counter Top Estimation Worksheet

Use This Worksheet to create a preliminary set of drawings and measurements for your counter tops. Then take this worksheet, along with any design idea you may have, to our show room where we can help you select a stone.

Step 1. Draw your counter top floor plan in the grid below. Refer to page 2 for common counter top lay outs.

Step 2. Section your drawings into rectangles and squares and number them 1,2,3, etc..



Step 3. Record the dimensions of the sections(in inches rounded to the nearest half inch) and then add the sections(1-5) to compute the total sq/ft for each section. Remember to add for any over hangs.
